Book the date now and plan to be with us. It's going to be great!!



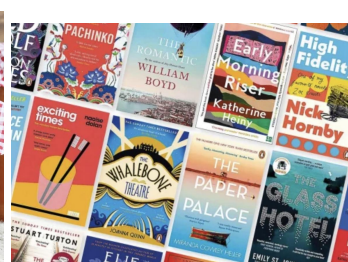
