We will continue to keep this situation and these people in our prayers.

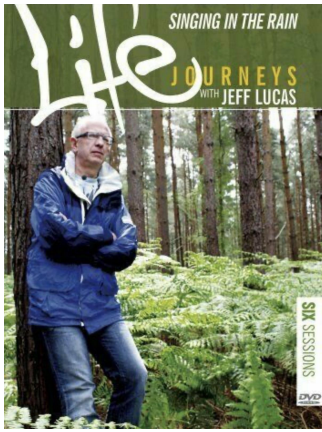
